## Atlantis Paradise Island

The Bahamas

Atlantis Paradise Island adds a slew of new bar and restaurant launches to celebrate its 25th anniversary. The Bahamian favorite has bolstered its gastronomic offerings with the addition of a number of new venues for 2023, including the ocean-inspired Italian restaurant Paranza by Michelin-starred chef Michael White. Notable for his New York City restaurants Marea, Ai Fiori and Osteria Morini, Michael joins Michelin star-rated chefs Nobu Matsuhisa of Nobu and José Andres, whose Fish by José Andres is at The Cove, to firmly establish Atlantis as the culinary center of The Bahamas. Join the quarter-century celebrations before embarking (or disembarking) on a Bahamian escape. Atlantis is ideally located on Paradise Island, the perfect gateway to the idyllic Exumas, Cat Island and the Abacos or Eleuthera.

**Casa Chablé**  
Tulum, Mexico

This recently opened Mexican retreat, which is located on an otherwise untouched stretch of the Caribbean Yucatan coast, lies just 22 miles south of Tulum. However, sitting in the heart of the UNESCO-designated Sian Ka'an Biosphere Reserve, it is as far away from Tulum's offerings as possible. The entire property, which started life as a private villa became a renovation project that, thanks to strict laws on any sort of development, has been rebuilt using only local materials such as tropical parota wood and palapa-style roofing. Even the stones and marbles come from the surrounding region. In addition, the property's main villa, which plays host to five rooms, and a further five standalone oceanfront bungalows, are completely powered by renewable solar and wind energy. There is a wellness curator, a thatched-roof restaurant (serving local fish and ingredients from the resort's organic gardens) and a spa, but the main draw is the seclusion along the 656' beach and acres of tropical jungle.
